- be fluent in German and proficient in English

- have experience of and commitment to supporting the pastoral needs of the students
- communicate with parents about students' progress in German learning
- work with colleagues to support and guide students to achieve their academic potential
- attend weekly staff meetings and collaborative planning times
- be fascinated by the process of learning for understanding, open to new ideas, humorous and flexible

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- have up-to-date knowledge of relevant legislation and guidance in relation to working with, and the protection of, children and young people
- display commitment to the protection and safeguarding of children and young people
