The IT Systems Administrator works directly for the Director of IT and is a part of the ISS IT Office. This position serves as a server, SaaS, and network systems administrator for the services supporting the school's digital environment.

The IT Systems Administrator is responsible for administration of ISS IT systems and services, e.g. Windows servers, Microsoft 365, Cisco Meraki Network, firewall, Linux servers, Windows desktop. Working in conjunction with the Director of IT, the IT Systems Administrator will perform various system administration tasks including system configuration, server upgrades and updates, server migrations, hardware, firmware and software deployment, investigation of technical solutions, installation of third party vendor solutions and evaluation of potential solutions, as well as management of ISS SaaS cloud solutions.

The successful candidate will have academic training related to this position.

Duties, Skills and Experience:

- Administrative experience of Microsoft server technologies, and Linux (e.g. CentOS, Ubuntu) Administrative experience of Microsoft 365 cloud solutions,; Active Directory,
- Working experience of PowerShell scripting, script development, and task automation
